CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. SCHOOL

- a. Ideally, participating schools should be in a DEIS area or in a rurally isolated/ socially or economically disadvantaged area.
- b. Schools participating in the Dynamics programme should NOT be participating in any other extra-curricular music programme.

2. MANAGEMENT SUPPORT

- a. The Dynamics Programme must have the full support of the principal, the entire staff and the Board of Management.
- b. The organising / class teacher must support the programme and be in attendance during lessons.
- c. It is helpful (but not essential) if the organising / class teacher has a musical background or experience

3. CLASS GROUP & LESSONS

- a. The Dynamics programme is designed for 1st or 2nd class pupils.
- b. The Dynamics programme is designed to be taught to a group of not more than 20 children in any given classroom.
- c. The Dynamics programme will be taught for one hour every day during school time ideally between 9am & 1pm, commencing in September and following the school year calendar.

4. VIOLINS

- a. Violins will be given on loan to participating schools. The violins remain the property of the Cross Border Orchestra of Ireland and must be returned in perfect condition to the CBOI at the end of the school year.
- b. Participating schools must be willing to take full responsibility for the safe, secure storage and care of the instruments. The school will be liable for any damages caused which the violins are

5. THE FUTURE

- a. Pending funding, CBOI intends to continue the project as long as possible. Participating schools must be willing to commit to the Dynamics Programme for a minimum of one year and possibly further years. Schools should be willing to continue the programme with the original class group AND start a new class group.
